About the MHC program:

The MHC program was developed by the Canadian Manufactured Housing Institute (CMHI) in collaboration with regional manufactured housing associations to provide a professional development opportunity for retailers, realtors, sales people, builders, community owners and managers.

Upon successful completion of the course and take home assignment, graduates will be enrolled as Manufactured Housing Consultants (MHC)TM in the national MHC Registry, receiving a Certificate and pin, earning the right to use the designation on business cards, stationery etc., receiving the MHC Newsletter and ongoing support.

There have been 179 MHC participants across Canada to date. The course has been offered for industry personnel in Alberta, Saskatchewan, Ontario, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island. This first B.C. course is being timed to coincide with the 5th Alberta course!

Manufactured Housing Association of British Columbia is the delivery agent for the first offering of the Manufactured Housing Consultant (MHC)TM course in B.C.

Registration:

The course fee covers all course materials, 250-page workbook, forms, marketing plans, checklists, tests, marking, lunches and breaks over the two days in Kamloops.
